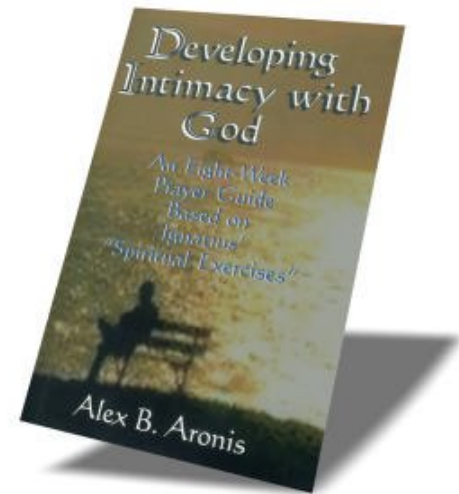

Intimate knowledge of Christ that I might be with Him, become like Him, and live for Him.

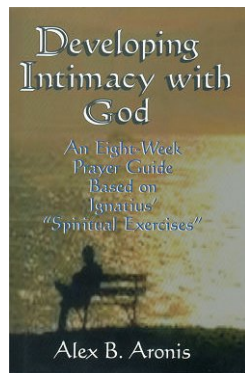
How This Conference Differs from Most

You will receive instruction on several very helpful ways to pray over passages of the Bible. These methods of prayer are taught in "*The Spiritual Exercises*" of Ignatius.

Each period of instruction is followed by a season of private, personal prayer so that you can try the method of prayer just taught. During the prayer time you will most probably find yourself receiving insights from the Lord, experiencing the Spirit's movement in your heart, and communing quietly with Christ as you rest in Him.

A feedback session comes next when the entire group meets together to share insights from the assigned Bible passage, raise questions about the method of prayer that was used, or talk about the experience of communion with Christ during the prayer period. These group feedback sessions are informational, fun, and inspirational.

You will be able to apply what you learn during the conference by going through the prayer exercises in Dr Aronis' book: "*Developing Intimacy with God: An Eight-Week Prayer Guide Based on Ignatius' 'Spiritual Exercises.'*"
